POLICY: Fine Free Library

Policy 3007

The library no longer charges daily late fines on items that are overdue, and if your home library is Oakmont, any existing fines lingering on your account have been waived.

You may still be charged for lost or damaged materials, printed items, or other fees.

All library materials will still have a due date, and books that are lost, damaged, or otherwise not returned will be charged. As the due date approaches, the library will notify the patron of the due date and ask that they return it (if the item is not eligible for renewal).

If the item is six weeks overdue, a bill to replace the item will be issued, and if an item is more than six weeks overdue, the account may be referred to a collection agency depending on the patron's registering library.
